So with all of the above in mind, regarding what the bible reveals....Jesus says that if you are not born again you cannot see the kingdom of God. This new covenant term means that if you are not ...**born again** or "**regenerated**".... you cannot go to Heaven which is the abode of God.... The only alternative if you are not regenerated is Hell .

The important question you should ask yourself is
How do I get "**born again**" to receive eternal salvation?
Below the bible is quoted saying.....

*John 3:15 That whosoever **believeth in him** should not perish, but have eternal life.*

*John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever **believeth in him** should not perish, but have everlasting life.*

John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

*John 3:18 He that **believeth on him** is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.*

The important point is to **believe in Him** (Jesus) and this belief comes by faith through the Word of God.....

Rom 10:17 *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

So with all of the above in mind, regarding what the bible reveals....Jesus says that if you are not born again you cannot see the kingdom of God. This new covenant term means that if you are not ...**born again** or "**regenerated**".... you cannot go to Heaven which is the abode of God.... The only alternative if you are not regenerated is Hell .
